The Alcohol and Drug Intervention Program

Your student has been referred to the IUSD Alcohol and Drug Intervention Program. This program is designed to give students more information and support around alcohol or drug use and to decrease the likelihood of continued use. The program has two components – an online education course and an intake session by a Wellness Coordinator to determine if additional support is needed. The online course is designed for youth who were found in possession of alcohol or drugs, possession of drug paraphernalia or consumption of alcohol. This is an 8-hour online course that is available 24/7, is self-paced and provides a Certificate of Completion. Please see the instructions for enrolling in the course below.

The intake session may indicate additional support such as school-based counseling or it may be determined that an outside referral is needed for more intensive specialized intervention. Wellness Coordinators also can assist with referrals for additional resources for the student or family if desired.

Instructions for the Alcohol and Drug Intervention Class:

1. Go to www.alcoholdrugclass.com/IUSD.aspx
2. Scroll down to **Available Minor in Possession (MIP) Classes**.
3. Find the **8-Hour Level 1 Minor in Possession (MIP) Class**.
4. Click on the red **REGISTER** button.
5. Complete the registration information.
6. When you get to **Product Selection** look for the *OFFER CODE* box and enter **IUSD19** (this will override the need for payment and allow the registration to be completed).
7. Begin the course and complete the course at your own pace.
8. When you finish the course print out the **Certificate of Completion** and return it to the School Administrator.
