## **IUSD Alcohol and Drug Intervention Program**

## **Instructions for School Administrators**

Criteria for enrollment into the Intervention Program:

- Student is up for suspension for an alcohol or drug-related incident at school or during school-related activities.
- This is a first time alcohol or drug offense for the student OR they have not completed an Alcohol and Drug Intervention Program in the past.

## Steps to enroll:

- 1. Student is suspended for alcohol/drug offense by school administrator. (Please consider reducing the number of days assigned to the suspension when a student is willing to complete the Intervention Program.)
- 2. Administrator explains the two components of the IUSD Alcohol and Drug Intervention Program:
  - a. The online course (if this is a first time alcohol or drug offense for the student)
  - b. The completion of 1 intake session with the Wellness Coordinator at which time the Wellness Coordinator will triage the level of support needed to include, but not limited to:
    - Support group through Project Success
    - Direct counseling support with Wellness Coordinator
    - Outside referral for more intensive specialized intervention
- 3. Administrator gives the student and parent the "Alcohol and Drug Intervention Parent Letter" along with a copy of the suspension.
- 4. If this is a first time alcohol and drug offense for the student, student uses offer code (listed in parent letter) to register for and complete online course during out-of-school suspension.
- 5. Student completes online course and turns in the Certificate of Completion (provided in the course) to Administrator.

- 6. Wellness Coordinator will do an intake with the student and determine the level of support needed.
- 7. Wellness Coordinator will document the intake meeting and next steps in the Counseling screen in Aeries, including the following information:
  - o Date of Alcohol and Drug Intake meeting with student
  - Next Steps/Support Plan
  - Date the plan was communicated to team members and the support provider
- 8. Administrator or designee will follow up with Wellness Coordinator to check the status of support provided.
