Staff Duties and Responsibilities

Teachers:

The instructional plan for summer school focuses on the rapid acquisition of reasonable oral language fluency for English Learners at the emerging levels of English proficiency. Teachers are required to have an understanding of the following:

- Learning environments that are culturally and linguistically responsive and inclusive
- Implementation of The California English Language Development Standards
- Analysis of student results from the *English Language Proficiency Assessment of CA* (ELPAC) for instructional planning
- Integration of academic language instruction across the content areas
- Effective strategies for active engagement
- Design of authentic opportunities for structured conversational discourse and collaboration.

Teachers are expected to:

- Teach the designated cross-content curriculum
- Administer progress monitoring assessments to ensure students are making progress on the targeted essential ELD standards
- Provide timely feedback to students on their progress
- Attend training meetings to familiarize themselves with the program design, learning materials, and resources available
- Participate in weekly on-campus PLC meetings
- Respond to all student, parent, and administrative communication daily
- Complete supervision duties as assigned

Paraprofessionals/Instructional Assistant:

The Instructional Assistant role for summer school focuses on the implementation of effective co-teaching strategies that support classroom instruction on a daily basis. Instructional Assistants are to:

- Contribute to learning environments that are culturally and linguistically responsive and inclusive
- Facilitate station teaching and learning centers
- Monitor cooperative group work
- Implement the classroom norms and behavior systems
- Supervise students as assigned
- Assist with distribution and preparation of instructional materials and supplies
