

How to Create an Apple ID on an iPad

Topic: Apple ID

Product: Apple App Store on iOS

This guide assumes that your iPad/iPod has already been through the out-of-the-box first run process, is connected to the WiFIUSD wireless network, and is not signed into the App Store with an existing Apple ID.

Access the App Store

Once connected to the WiFIUSD wireless network, locate and tap the App Store icon on your device. Navigate to any FREE app in the App Store and attempt to install the app. This process will not actually install the selected app, so any free app will do. You will be prompted with the above screen. Tap the “Create New Apple ID” button.



Apple ID and Password

Follow the on-screen prompts and accept the Apple ID license agreement until you arrive at the “Apple ID and Password” section. Since the device you are using is an IUSD owned device, you will need to use your IUSD email address as your Apple ID. Fill out the displayed fields, following Apple’s password requirements and account security questions, and continue scrolling down.





If you provide a payment method now, you will not be charged until you make a purchase. If you select None, you will be asked to provide a payment method when you make your first purchase.





Apple uses industry-standard encryption to protect the confidentiality of your personal information.

Ensure that the “None” option is selected, and scroll to fill out the “Billing Address” section. Even though there is no billing method on file, Apple requires this information. All of the required fields are pictured in red. You should use your actual first and last name, and your school site’s street address and phone number.

Verify Your Account

If you have correctly provided the information required, the next dialogue box will ask you to verify your new account. You will need to check the inbox for your IUSD email address that you used to create the Apple ID for a verification email from Apple. If one does not appear within a few minutes, try closing your inbox and re-opening it, or perform a “Send/Receive” action.



After opening the verification email from Apple, you will be directed to an Apple website and prompted to log in with your new Apple ID and the password that you just established during this process. You can return to your iPad/iPod and now sign into the App Store and download free apps.
