

CAREGIVER vs. POWER OF ATTORNEY

CAREGIVER AFFIDAVIT

POWER OF ATTORNEY

Caregiver CAN:

- ✚ May enroll a minor in school AND must have parent contact info on IUSD coversheet.
- ✚ Consent to school-related medical care.
- ✚ Parent maintains full educational rights to student.

Power of Attorney CAN:

- ✚ May enroll a minor in school.
- ✚ Has consent to represent child in matters relating to instructional planning, educational placement, reviewing and revising IEP's, and in all matters relating to the provision of a free appropriate public education of the child.
- ✚ Power of Attorney form must be signed by the parent. (See page 3 of the POA for specifics)
- ✚ Parent maintains full educational rights to the student.
- ✚ May excuse absences.
- ✚ May withdraw student.

Caregiver CANNOT:

- ✚ Does NOT have access to educational records.
- ✚ May NOT attend school meetings, conferences, or discuss any school-related matters with teachers.
- ✚ May NOT excuse absences.
- ✚ May NOT withdraw student.

Power of Attorney CANNOT:
