#### **CAREGIVER AFFIDAVIT**

#### **POWER OF ATTORNEY**

#### **Caregiver CAN:**

- ♣ May enroll a minor in school AND must have parent contact info on IUSD coversheet.
- Consent to school-related medical care.
- Parent maintains full educational rights to student.

### Power of Attorney <u>CAN</u>:

- ♣ May enroll a minor in school.
- Has consent to represent child in matters relating to instructional planning, educational placement, reviewing and revising IEP's, and in all matters relating to the provision of a free appropriate public education of the child.
- Power of Attorney form must be signed by the parent. (See page 3 of the POA for specifics)
- Parent maintains full educational rights to the student.
- May excuse absences.
- May withdraw student.

## Caregiver **CANNOT**:

- Does NOT have access to educational records.
- May NOT attend school meetings, conferences, or discuss any school-related matters with teachers.
- May NOT excuse absences.
- May NOT withdraw student.
