CALPADS – The Data

- Data is submitted to CALPADS at least once a week and updates the state system with student enrollment, demographics and program data for any student with an SSID on a daily basis.
- At any given point of time, data can be extracted from the system for reporting data.
- Reports certified through CALPADS is the official reporting entity for the state.
- Enrollment brings in a large percentage of the funding for the district known as the LCFF. The LCFF allows money to be portioned off through the LCAP.
- English Learners, homeless and free and reduced students bring in additional funding.
