Overview

- Many systems support different department needs to meet their reporting requirements. For example, MCS for Nutrition Services; SEIS for Special Education; Aeries, Canvas, School Messenger and Destiny for Libraries.
- Data accuracy is **CRITICAL** in all systems – they intersect one another and are constantly changing and in perpetual motion within and outside our LEA.

"Sorry, your password must contain a capital letter, two numbers, a symbol, an inspiring message, a spell, a gang sign, a hieroglyph and the blood of a virgin"



- Data elements are extracted from Aeries, the Student Information System (SIS) and uploaded into CALPADS every two weeks or more frequently.
- CALPADS is the repository for all data to be reported.
- CALPADS is a robust, **state-wide** system tracking every TK-12 California public school student with a unique State-wide Student ID number (SSID).
- In 2014-15, CALPADS tracked over 6,235,000 students at 1,022 districts or 10,393 California public schools.
- Student demographics, courses, discipline, assessments, staff and other facts are gathered for state and federal reporting.

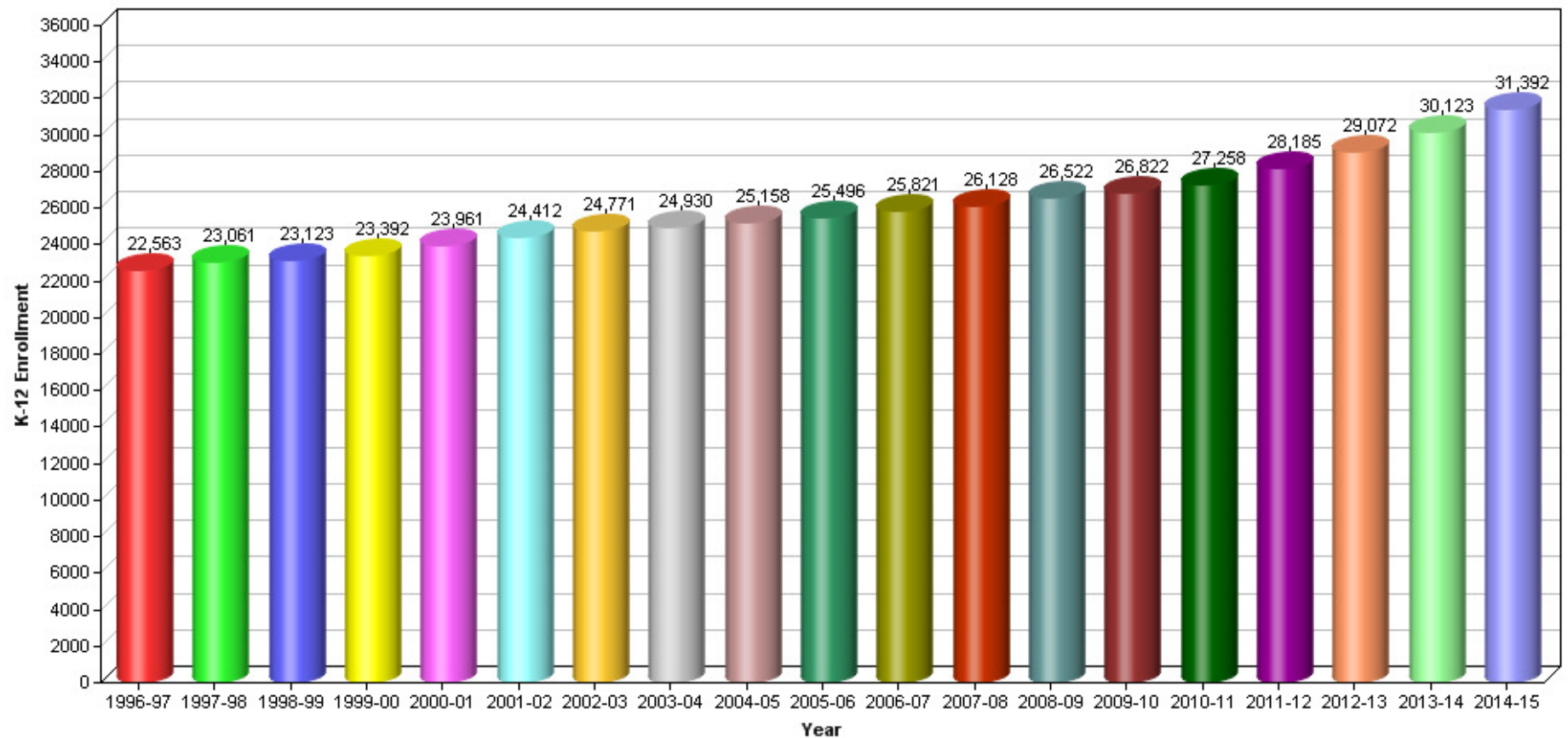


K-12 Public School Enrollment

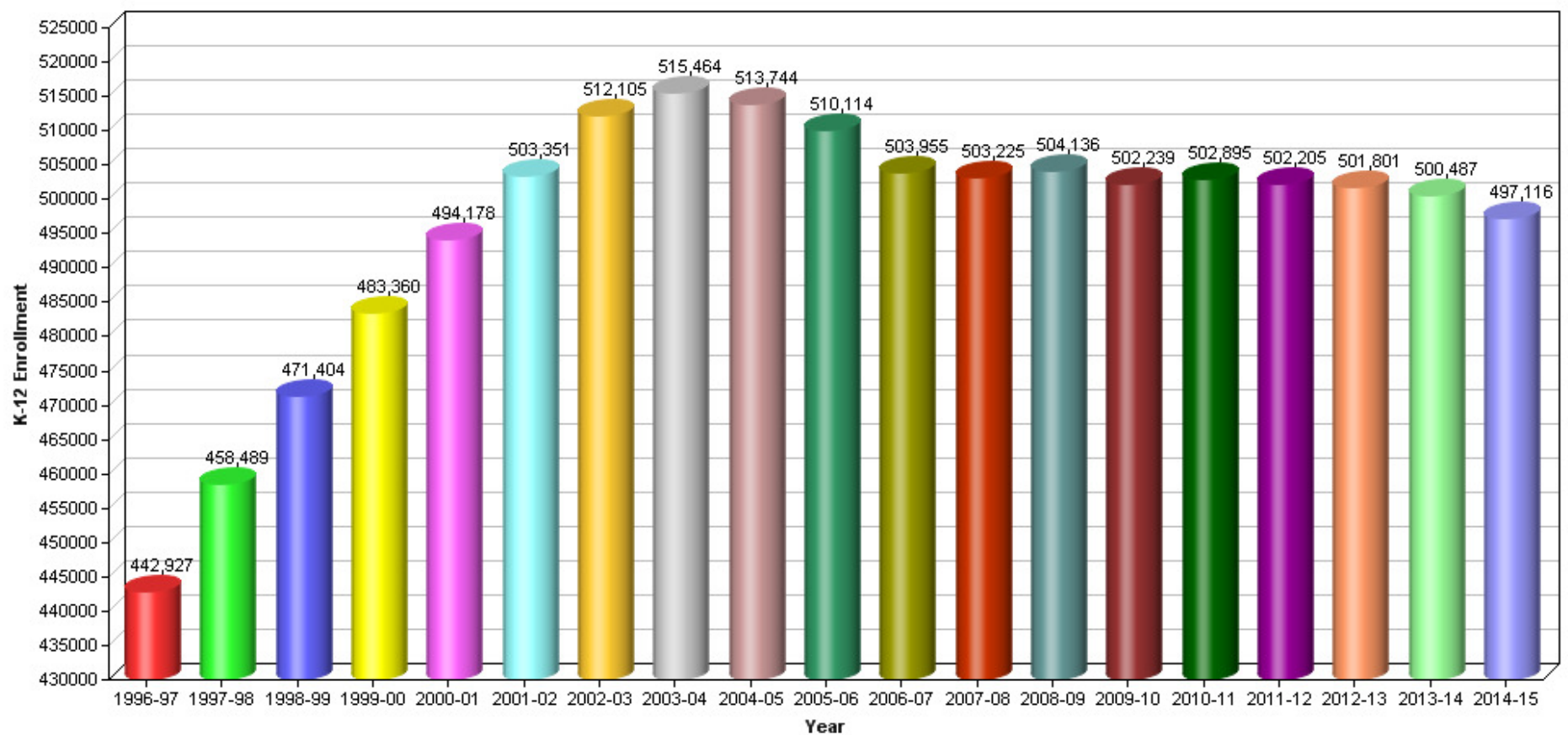




K-12 Public School Enrollment ORANGE County

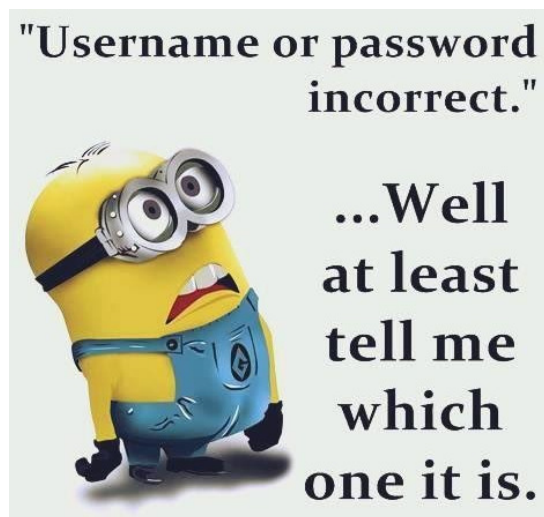
Local Control Funding Formula (LCFF)

- LEAs receive funding based on the demographic profile of the students they serve and gain greater flexibility to use these funds to improve outcomes of students.
- A supplemental grant equal to 35 percent of the base grant is provided for each English learner, economically disadvantaged or foster youth pupil. Counts are unduplicated.
- We put extra focus on students who are English Learners, Economically Disadvantaged and Foster students.

Local Control and Accountability Plan (LCAP)

- The LCAP is an important component of the LCFF.
- Under the LCFF all LEAs are required to prepare an LCAP, which describes how they intend to meet annual goals for all pupils, with specific activities to address state and local priorities identified pursuant to *EC Section 52060(d)*.

- The Legislature, state and federal government change the rules of the game or the elements to be reported often and sometimes with very short notice.
- CALPADS is a system that supports the state. At times it will be slow or not operational.
- Currently there are over 156 known system errors that pertain to how the data is processed for the reports.

Most Common Exit Codes Used

160 – PreK-12. Use this code if you are certain the student is enrolled in another California public school. If the student does not get picked up by the other LEA, this will show up as a Lost Transfer (a possible dropout for your school if the student does not subsequently enroll in another California public school on or before Census Day – 1st Wednesday in October).

165 – Involuntary displaced transfer to another school (With-in or Outside California) due to disciplinary actions. Referred by a juvenile court judge or other correctional or judicial official. When using this code, the receiving school's CDS code must be keyed in.

167 – Referred by school for non-disciplinary reasons to an alternative ed school or independent study program.

180 – Student left the school for a private institution **in California**.

200 – Student moved out of state.

240 – Student moved out of the country.

440 – Program or grade level change **within the same school**. This code is used when a student has an independent contract or changes teachers within the same school. The 440 code should **NOT** be used as the last enrollment record for the student.

450 – PreK-6. Leaves the school and the whereabouts of the student are **unknown**.
