③ Summer Testing/March Enrollment:

- 2017-18 Tickets-To-Test are being printed and will be mailed out by the end of the month. Email Samira Kassouni if you have any questions. The new Green tickets should be used for 2017-18 appointments only. Please continue to use your <u>blue</u> tickets for this school year.
- Summer testing for the 2017-18 school year will begin July 5th. Year-round sites will be scheduled that first week to ensure students are tested prior to the start of their school year (July 12th).
- March web-enrollment for 2017-18: Test appointments can be scheduled as soon as you begin to enroll. Please complete the new <u>Green</u> Ticket-to-Test and have it visible <u>prior</u> to calling for the appointment. Do not try to schedule all of your appointments at one time as it congests our ability to access the appointment calendar for other sites.
