AERIES - Special Ed Assessment Status Tag

Status code: "A" is for Assessment in Progress. <u>Temporarily being assessed by school psychologist.</u>

There are two student status tags A and D in AERIES to identify the students that are being assessed for special ed eligibility but who are not enrolled in IUSD. This is for a student who is an IUSD resident but does not attend an IUSD school. We are required to assess students if parents request an assessment if they have provided valid residency documentation. Assessments usually take about 60 days. After the 60 days the status code will be "D- Sped Assessment complete". Then the student will remain at their private school or if parents accept the offer of services enroll in an IUSD school.

When a parent web enrolls their student you can bring that record in from AIR and mark it with a status of "A" (Assessment in Progress) instead of "W" (web enrolled). There will be a pink border to further help to identify these students. Enroll student but do not activate them in attendance.

Note* These student records will show up on your Attendance Audit Listing. (Enrolled but not in attendance) Just ignore!

Once the assessment is complete the psychologist will notify you when they are complete. If the student is not going to enroll you can change the status tag to "**D**" (Sp Ed Assessment Complete). The records with these tags will not roll over into the next year's database.

Status Tag: D code - *Description changed over the summer*

WAS: Did not Qualify for Special Ed

NOW: Sp Ed Assessment Complete

When a student has completed 'Assessment', change Status tag to D code.
