What does EXPMP mean on a child's immunization?

It means the child was part of a vaccine study conducted by Kaiser. For most children in the study, Kaiser's automated immunization tracking system changed these children's records to replace "EXPMP" entries with identification of the vaccine actually received, such as "PCV" or "EXPMNC." For children who left the Kaiser system before this happened and the record still says "EXPMP," the family can call their last Kaiser immunization provider to obtain a new yellow California Immunization Record card with identification of the doses.
