

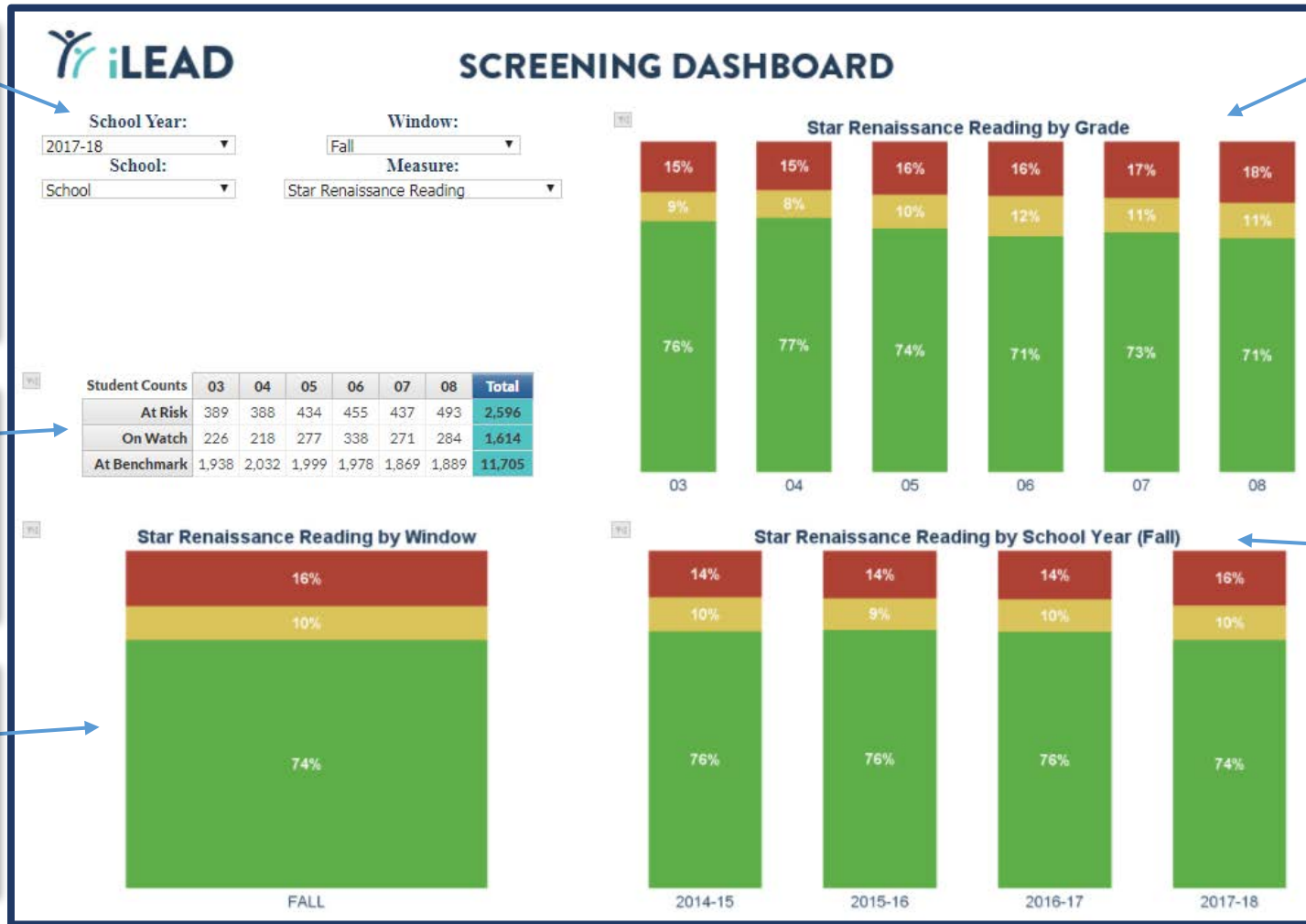
Screening Dashboard Guide

The Screening Dashboard is designed to give an overview of ELA and Math universal screening results to site administrators and teacher leaders to be used as part of a multi-tiered system of support framework. This data can be used to identify school-wide needs and plan/allocate resources to support teachers and students. Drop down menus allow site to select data by school year, testing window, and all ELA and Math universal screening measures.

Number count of students, by grade, on the selected screening assessment.

Shows whole school results from all testing windows within the selected school year.



Results, by grade level, of the selected screening assessment window. Click on the individual sections to drill down into detailed student results (drill down is only available for the current school year).

Year over year results (whole school) to show trends and history in student performance.

Who Has Access to the Screening Dashboard?

Principals, Assistant Principals, School Support TOSAs, School Psychologists, Intervention Lead Teachers, Title I Coordinators

When is data updated in the Screening Dashboard?

- STAR Reading and Math data are uploaded nightly during the testing window.
- LPA data are uploaded at the end of the testing window.
- Only assessments during the IUSD testing windows are included in the report.
- If multiple records are available for a student during a single testing window, the first record will be used.
